

**2010 SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**  
**American Postal Workers - Accident Benefit Association**  
**Scholarship Program**

- 1. The scholarship announcement and applications will be mailed to all ABA Directors, local and state presidents no later than March of each year. The announcement and application will be printed in the ABA Quarterly News Digest as well as posted on the official web site of the ABA. The deadline for returning the scholarship application (s) will be set by the ABA.**
- 2. All entrants must submit a completed application which will be verified by the president or ABA representative of their local or state or by the ABA national office. Applications properly submitted will be entered into a drawing for the one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00) scholarship. Entrants must be a graduating high school senior who is the son, daughter or legal ward of a member of the ABA.**
- 3. The scholarship award is limited to a one time amount of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars. One (1) scholarship will be awarded per calendar year.**
- 4. The scholarship drawing will be held at the office the ABA no later than June of each year. This drawing will be strict "luck of the draw", meaning the entrant pulled will be the winner. No preferential treatment will be afforded to any entrant. All applicants will be assigned a random number for the drawing. The winner will be drawn from amongst all applicants and the winner notified by certified mail .**
- 5. The scholarship will be paid directly to the school that the winner designated on their application. The winner will be required to submit an acceptance letter and a photograph accompanied by a biography which will appear in an issue of the ABA Quarterly Digest.**
- 6. The national and assistant national director will be the coordinators of the scholarship program with the authority to settle any or all eligibility requirements or disputes that may arise.**
